
Our Mission

Our Purpose

The purpose of PLF is to sustain the mission established by Paul Lammermeier - to support children and youth in Lima, Peru, with homes centered on family and Jesuit values. "I am deeply grateful for Paul's life, and for his great influence on my life. He had a unique version of love for his students and his kids in Peru. He just loves uniquely well, especially effective in the challenging years of adolescence." - Tom Green





- <u>1964</u>: Paul begins his career teaching at his alma mater, *St. Ignatius High School* in **Cleveland, OH**.
- <u>1974</u>: Paul moves to **Cincinnati** to teach at *St. Xavier High School* and establishes their Community Service Program.
- <u>1984</u>: Paul receives a grant from the *Greater Cincinnati Foundation* for mission trips to **Peru**.
- **<u>1988</u>**: Paul permanently relocates to **Lima, Peru**.



Establishing PLF: Paul's answer...

- <u>1993</u>: Paul witnesses that some of his students lack parental support; he adopts Marco Antonio, Edgar, and then Donato.
- <u>1995</u>: *The Paul Lammermeier Foundation (PLF)* is founded. Paul forms a Peruvian organization, *Asociación Casa Javier (ACJ)*, to manage and oversee operations in Peru. PLF purchases it's first home for \$75,000, opening *Casa Javier*.



The Mission Grows: Paul leaves a legacy...



- <u>2002</u>: PLF purchases *Casa Ignacio* for \$134,000 our second home for the university-aged young men living at *Casa Javier*.
- <u>2013</u>: PLF purchases our third home for \$285,000, opening *Casa Teresa* to serve girls and young women.
- <u>2022</u>: Paul passes away in August.
- **2023:** PLF identifies a fourth home for the older girls, *Casa Edith*.
- <u>2024</u>: Carrying the Legacy | Building Bright Futures Campaign is launched.

- 35% live in poverty
- 15 years of education on average
- 12% drop out of school by 13
- 34% are in the workforce
